Program Description:

An engaging course providing officers with effective, real-life tools and strategic communication techniques to enhance officer safety and improve interactions between the police and the public. Officers will learn how to respond safely and effectively to community needs through the implementation of procedural justice and de-escalation strategies for use before, during and after interactions with community members. Created by Long Beach Police Department Sergeant Jason Lehman and facilitated by a team of law enforcement and community leaders, this course incorporates thought-stimulating discussions, personal perspectives and scenario-based exercises that challenge the status quo and engages participants for effective learning and leadership development.

Completion of this course satisfies the POST "Perishable Skills" training requirement for Strategic Communication & 8 hours of CPT credit.

- Demonstrate how community partnerships improve officer safety
- Recognize the importance of "Event + Response = Outcome (E+R=O)"
- Utilize de-escalation techniques without jeopardizing officer safety
- Dissect WYSM's 12 engagement strategies - 120 seconds to build trust
- Improve upon "Best Practice" Strategic Communication techniques
- Research positive and negative impacts of social media
- Discuss how to empower youth to act as a force multiplier in your community
- Learn 10 ways to assist peers with unresolved trauma - "10 F's" by Gordon Graham
- Review the "Tenets" of Procedural Justice
