COURSE OVERVIEW

This course gives law enforcement practitioners, investigators, supervisors, and managers a practical understanding of digital evidence, artificial intelligence, and their expanding roles in modern criminal investigations.

REAL-WORLD INVESTIGATIVE APPLICATIONS

The training focuses on real-world investigative capabilities rather than technical theory. Attendees will explore how digital evidence and AI-assisted tools can help analyze large volumes of information - including reports, interviews, jail calls, video, cellular data, social media, geo-location information, and other digital evidence - to identify relationships, contradictions, timelines, patterns, and potential investigative leads.

RESPONSIBLE AI IMPLEMENTATION

The course also addresses responsible AI use within law enforcement agencies, including security, CJIS compliance, source verification, traceability to original evidence, investigative capability, and operational value. Practical examples will show how agencies are using AI today and how it can be incorporated into investigative workflows while maintaining human review, transparency, accountability, and sound investigative practices.
